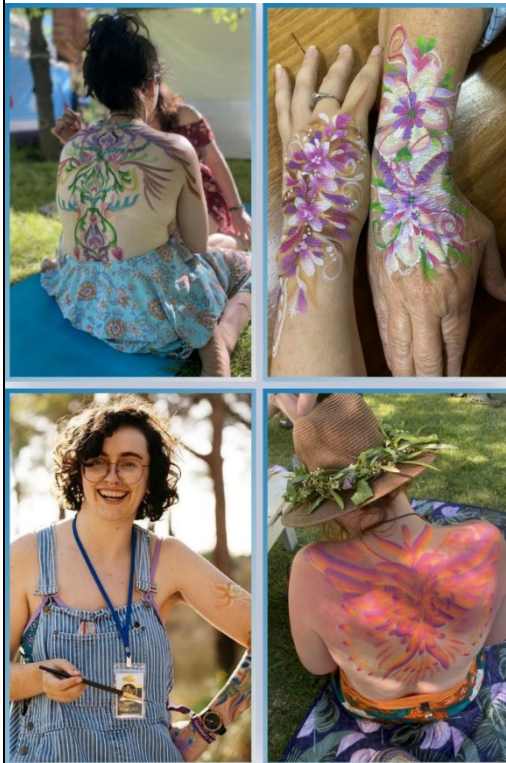

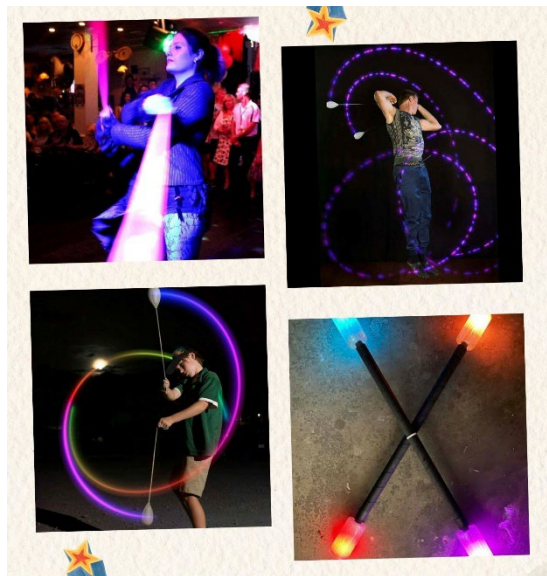


Pulse Circus Skills
